

RED WINE DOURO DOC

The name "Sarilhos" means "Troubles" in rural slang. It's a red wine from the Special Winery Region of "Douro" in the North of Portugal.

The wine is produced in the valley of "Vilariça" and it's composed of the following grape casts: Touriga Franca (35%), Tinta Roriz (45%) and Touriga Nacional (20%).

The grapes are harvested by hand in the first week of September, every year. After a soft cold maceration, the wine is produced in stainless steel containers creating slow maturation.

"Sarilhos" it's a robust wine with good spices flavoring. The warm properties of the vineyard are clearly sensed in it's full flavor.

It's better served between 16 and 18 degrees Celsius with red meet dishes.

TASTING:

Exquisite scent, fruity, strong in mature red fruits, full flavor and robust.
